Spring Forest Qigong - Level 1 Saturday, February 5 • 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Hope Interfaith Center facilitated by Lois Weber

Discover your natural ability to heal yourself and help others heal themselves.

Qigong is an ancient form of Chinese healing. It works with the body's energy or Qi. When the Qi becomes blocked in the body, sickness, pain and other health problems may occur. Through simple movements and meditation, you will learn to remove blockages and balance the body's energy so that it can heal. These movements can be done while lying down, sitting or standing.

Qigong heals the whole body in a perfect way—mentally, physically, emotionally and spiritually at the same time. Some of the benefits include increased energy, improved health and focus and enhanced self awareness.

Classes are based on the principles and techniques of Spring Forest Qigong, a medical Qigong. These techniques which are taught by breathing, postures, sounds and movements are simple, yet powerful enough to relieve physical pain, reduce stress, depression and address many other health concerns. These techniques also work well with Modern day medicine. Approximately 45 minutes is allowed for lunch. There is a kitchen with a fridge and microwave available if you wish to bring your lunch. There are also a few eating places nearby.

The cost is \$75.00 (Repeat fee \$50.00). The manual and other learning materials are available for purchase.
