A message from Reverend Janice Hope Gorman:

“Summer Mystery School 2009 at HIC”

Dear Friends,

Once upon a time, in the summer of 1965, there was a young girl named Janice. One day she was cleaning at Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Mankato, Minnesota. All of a sudden, a swirling fog began to appear to her, and she could see the flicker of a light, a pulsating glow. As she paused for a moment to observe, the tiny flare of light expanded in size and appeared as a young girl about the age of 15, maybe 16. As Janice moved closer to the radiance, it instantly changed her life! “Are you the angel of help I am seeking?” she asked. “No,” came the answer from this soft powerful feminine body. With a wink of her eye and a tilt of her head she was gone! That happened 44 years ago on or around July 22nd.
