"People Who Live Deeply and Fully Deserve Awards Too"

Award ceremonies are very popular. From the Academy Awards to the People's Choice Awards, to high school award assemblies, to graduation awards- we honor those who achieve. I believe achievement is valuable, but I also believe we focus too much attention on accomplishments and not enough attention on those who live as human "beings" instead of human "doings."

What if we gave process awards instead of product awards? What if we presented awards to people who were living fully and deeply, who shared themselves with others, and journeyed to attain SPIRITUAL CONNECTION and INNER PEACE? There will probably never be an "Inner Peace Award" ceremony or a "Spiritually Evolved Person Award" event, or a "Quality of Life" prize. But it is worth thinking about awards that come from inside—from one's spiritual realm. I propose the following awards to be given to human beings who are successful in these realms.

The Loyal Friend Award-—given to people who put time and energy into building strong, committed friendships. These people are honest, and they share caring feedback when a friend is in trouble. They sometimes go out of their way to remind a friend that he or she is special. They have clear boundaries, can be open and vulnerable, and know when to back away and let someone be.

The Committed Parent Award—given to parents who are caring, patient and committed. These parents take the time to teach communications and intimacy, in addition to driving children to soccer and basketball games. They attend hundreds of assemblies and concerts in hot stuffy auditoriums, and yell, Good for you; you can do it! They know when to push, when to be quiet, when to ask and when to listen.

The Mentorship Award—Given to people who nourish the personal, professional and spiritual growth of others. Mentors share insights, knowledge and awareness with a less experienced person. They give unsel-

fishly and reap benefits of joy when others learn and succeed. Teachers are often mentors, but anyone can mentor another person's growth and recovery process, including sponsors, scout leaders and coaches.

The Simplicity Award—given to people who do not buy into the materialism and greediness of the world. This award would go to people who live humbly and who try to create peace and harmony.

The Appreciation Award—given to those who are free of the endless search for happiness, and who appreciate what they already have. These individuals don't strive for power over others. They realize that freedom comes from not trying to control everything and everyone.

The Authenticity Award—for those who move beyond the lies and denial of an addicted society. They are able to ignore the fads and trends of the day and look for something deeper to identify with. They own their male and female energies, they can be strong, assertive, tender and vulnerable. They accept their limitations and realize that they also

have a dark side. They do not hide, deny or ignore their pain. They never have to prove anything to anyone.

The Stewardship Award—for those who have a deep reverence for nature. They nurture the earth like a child, and rejoice in the miracle of natural resources. They are conscious of the abundance of air and water but are aware that resources must be respected and preserved.

The Dedication Award—given to people who care about making the world a better place. They give themselves to a cause they believe in, and are committed to bringing some type of healing to a weary world.

The Persistence Award—given to people who don't get much praise or glory but who work on the front lines every day. These are the teachers, clerks, gas station attendants, etc., who provide direct service, and who are out there with the public. Some work with children, the handicapped, the mentally ill or the homeless. They hang in there on a daily basis and try to enrich the lives of others.

Quality of Life Award—for those who live fully, and are committed to becoming whole, complex, loving people. These individuals are able to laugh and cry, learn from mistakes, and accept life's challenges and disappointments.

If we rented a large coliseum and paid a million dollars for flowers, microphones and television coverage, I wonder if the recipients of these awards would attend. They might be too busy living to show up. They might find applause unnecessary, because they are recipients of the most prestigious honor of all: the gift of life itself.

Since the inception of the Hope Interfaith Seminary, we have ordained many interfaith ministers. All are working in their own special ways to transform our society to a global community of Love.

The first six months of study is about the discovery of Self, after which you will begin to discover a spiritual fellowship called interfaith which is now transforming our society. The interfaith/oneness story includes a mix of traditions where there is a sense that God/Goddess/Essence resides in the image of man. Spiritual counseling techniques and the study of energy is included in these classes. This thirteen-month program starts in March 2014. We will meet one weekend a month at HIC, beginning at 7 p.m. Friday evening, concluding at 5:00 p.m. Saturday afternoon. You will stay overnight and food will be communally shared. This class is for all those who are called to be leaders and ordained interfaith ministers. The cost per weekend is \$165.00 which must be paid monthly. Upon completion you will be an ordained minister, and have the legal privileges of marrying, burying, and

baptism. There are many networks for international interfaith organizations that share this reflection of friendship of peace that is initiated by an interfaith life of ONENESS.
