#### From the East:

Highway 14 West to Highway 22 South. Turn right on Hoffman Rd. (past East High School, cross Victory Dr.) Hoffman Road becomes Glenwood Ave. (curvy road). Turn left onto Pohl Rd. The Center is the magenta-colored building on the hill on the right.

#### From the North:

Highway 169 South to Highway 22 South (one block past the last stop light in St. Peter) Turn right on Hoffman Rd. (past East High School, cross Victory Dr.) Hoffman Road becomes Glenwood Ave. (curvy road). Turn left onto Pohl Rd. The Center is the magenta-colored building on the hill on the right.

## **Leadership Class in 2016**

#### Potentially Starting in March 2016...

Right now we are meeting once a month on the second Sunday of the month and we are thinking about doing a second service during the fourth Sunday of each month. We will be looking for your feedback of this suggestion soon. We would not be starting this until the Spring of 2016.

#### **OUR PHILOSOPHY**

### **Table Talk - Belonging**

#### Third Sunday of every month at 10:00 a.m.

Table Talk/Salon has had very low attendance so we are contemplating whether to have two services each month. As always, I am thinking about what people need at this time to help them experience belonging and meaning. I am hearing a lot about loneliness these days with many of my clients as well as people I meet outside of the Hope Interfaith Center. What is the opposite of loneliness? Is it belonging?

I know as humans, we need to belong to one another, to our friends and families, to our culture and country, and to our world. Belonging is primal, fundamental to our sense of happiness and well-being.

Our interests, motivation, health and happiness are inextricably tied to the feelings that we belong to a greater community that may share common interests and aspirations. Universal Love, acceptance, peace and joy as well as believing in the DIVINE in all of us and all nature has been a want of mine as well as wanting to create a space and place for others to come join in an experience where they can feel the love. The benefits of coming together in prayer, fellowship, fun and laughter are immeasurable.

Isolation, loneliness and low social status can harm a person's subjective sense of well-being, as well as his or her intellectual achievement, immune function and health. Research shows that even a single instance of exclusion can undermine well-being, IQ performance, and self-control. So I am always inviting you to invite others to come to any group at the Hope Interfaith Center. I am talking to someone about the possibility of doing pipe ceremonies at our center on a regular basis as well as looking at finding a place to do sweat ceremonies.

So let us begin a "BELONGING INTERVENTION" on people you know that are lonely or who are looking for a space and place to come to. We all know someone who is struggling or yearning or wanting to grow with a community. Let us all reach out to people. I write out 3 cards a day to reach out within our community as well as the greater community to let people know about our center. I invite people to come to HIC. I tell people I care. I tell people that I wish them well. I remind them that they are loved and remembered. I also tell them they are missed.

Meaning is found in various ways—sometimes through family, religion and a sense of self. But certainly, one way to find meaning in life is by seeking out one or more places where we belong and where things make sense. Where do you belong? Who is your support family? "Support system" means just that: members of the system support one another. Of course we value independence, and friendship is not meant to undermine that value of alone time for contemplation. But it is important to cultivate friendships and relationships in community. Friendships assume our innocence. A friend applauds our desire to play big in life. A friend supports our efforts to live according to spiritual purpose. A friend is always ready to help us and forgive us. A true friend and family will see us at our worst, as well as at our best, but his or her love will not waver when we have failed to show our most positive features. A family of friends will not close their hearts when we have made a mistake. A family of friends will not condemn us but will compassionately support our return to a state of grace. A family of friends will refrain from criticism, because it hurts the friendship and it hurts the soul.

Honoring our connection to another person is a way of honoring God. A powerful connection to a group is a potent energy of group consciousness that can and does change the world. This is because the universe is a hologram.

Come join us at the Hope Interfaith Center for an experience of connectedness and please invite others to come and experience it as well.

## **Sunday Noon Meal at the Mankato Salvation Army**

Sunday, November 1, 11:00am - 1:30pm Volunteers needed to bring food and serve! Please sign up by Thursday, October 29!

The Sunday Noon Meal serves a healthy, full meal to those in our area who are in need of nourishment and fellowship. It is served every Sunday and uses the Salvation Army sight as its base facility. Currently more than 110 guests are served each Sunday. This mission came out of the Mankato Hunger Task Force which was formed in the mid-80's. Starting with 5 churches sharing the task, it now has evolved into a base of 14 spiritual communities working together! Hope Interfaith Center has agreed to provide and serve twice during each year. (This is very near and dear to Hope's Heart!)

Serving the Sunday Noon Meal involves the following: We will need approx. 16 people/units to help donate, make and serve the food. There are five categories – the main dish, a vegetable, salad, bread, butter and milk, and dessert. Jody has more information and there is a sign-up sheet at HIC.

On the Sunday we serve, we will meet at the Salvation Army at 11:00am. The meal is served from noon – 1:00pm and all volunteers should be able to leave, following clean up, by 1:30. This is a very worthwhile way to serve others and a great family activity, too. ### Interfaith center to plant peace pole in France

MANKATO — Every once in while Rev. Janice Gorman will visit one of several peace poles planted throughout Mankato by Hope Interfaith Center.

"I do that because I believe there's something happening in Mankato," she said. "This seems to be a community that gets behind projects like this."

Every time she sees one of the poles, "To tell you the truth, I become even more passionate about planting more poles. One institution, one person, one community can make a difference."

Peace poles are monuments displaying the message "May Peace Prevail on Earth," usually in a different language on each of four sides. Hope Interfaith Center has planted several of them, both locally and internationally, in Israel, Palestine, Turkey and Peru.

In Mankato and North Mankato, there are peace poles at the YWCA, Peace Park, South Central College, CADA and the First Congregational United Church of Christ, to name a few. There is also one in front of the Interfaith Center, given in memory of a member who died from cancer.

The next pole, to be the center's 11th, will be planted in France. Later this year one will be planted at the Coffee Hag. "This year, because it's a local and international project, we're going to plant two," Gorman said.

Gorman will be leading 18 people on a pilgrimage to Lourdes, France Oct. 14. She wants to plant a peace pole there because several journalists recently killed in an attack on the satirical newspaper Charlie Hebdo.

"The local one is at the Coffee Hag because they've created such an environment of peace and inclusivity there," she said. The peace poles are meant to inspire people to think of peace, Gorman said, then act to create it.

"I don't think peace is just simply the opposite of violence," she said. "I believe peace is an action, even more than a feeling. It's easy for people to have the fuzzy feeling of peace, that why I love the peace pole project. We're not simply talking about peace, we're acting it out."

She hopes that residents will sometimes visit the local poles as she does, and think on peace. "It's my hope that people look at the peace poles and stop, even for a moment, and reflect," she said. "The poles says 'May Peace Prevail on Earth.' To me, making that statement is a prayer. It's a prayer: let peace prevail on Earth."
