A Message From Reverend Janice Hope Gorman

Dear Friends,

As I ended last year, I was given several experiences that demonstrated the ongoing nature of our work here at the Hope Interfaith Center. The experience that I am going to talk about may give us all a preview of the next phase of the journey. Through experiences, I began to better understand energy outside of this physical dimension. I met the radiance of God/Goddess, Source, Oneness and left my body behind, experiencing the free energy of my spirit. It happened in the following way:

I awoke early morning December 7 at 3:40 a.m., the 75th anniversary of the attack of Pearl Harbor. I began to vibrate to an almost uncontrolla-

From the East:

Highway 14 West to Highway 22 South. Turn right on Hoffman Rd. (past East High School, cross Victory Dr.) Hoffman Road becomes Glenwood Ave. (curvy road). Turn left onto Pohl Rd. The Center is the magenta-colored building on the hill on the right.

From the North:

BEFORE HE MELTS AWAY- Before We Melt Away!

Welcome to our Spiritual Services!

Winter is upon us! And perhaps SNOW and COLD and SNOWMEN are here as well! I am going to share a story that will warm your heart because this is what we do here at the HOPE INTERFAITH CENTER. This is a story that will bring you back into the moment of NOW!

This story will give you the true meaning of Frosty the Snowman and this is a true story about a gentleman and his son who had cancer.

He was standing at the front of the classroom, leaning on a podium as thirty-three high school students stared at him. Some eyes were alive with interest, others were glazed with boredom. He was about to talk about a book of Don Quixote. You know the mad knight and windmills, puissant Biscayans, troublesome sheep, and now, with dreamy persistence, searches for the golden helmet of Mambrino. (If you haven't read the book perhaps you might want to)

Then there was a knock at the door, and the English department secretary told Mr. Hanmer, your wife is on the phone. She needs to speak with you immediately. It's urgent. This of course never sounds good. Stepping out of the classroom, he calls her and he hears her voice. "Come to the hospital as fast as you can," She says. "Something is wrong with Nino." Nino is twenty months old.

Entering the examination room, he sees his wife delicately holding their son as a doctor shines a little flashlight into his eyes. The doctor leaves the room, saying he is going to bring in his colleague. (Which never sounds good.) Two doctors enter, then three. He has a sinking feeling in his chest and a constricting sensation in his throat. There is a smell of hand soap and hospital, the sound of squeaky shoes on pearly-white floors and machines quietly whirring. Finally one doctor tells Mr. and Mrs. Hanmer, "He has a tumor."

Hours later they leave the hospital, knowing only that their child has retinoblastoma-malignant cancer of the eye. Fear of course, anger of course, confusion of course and anything else that goes through a body of a parent when they hear that their son has a tumor. (I know what it feels like to have a little boy die at the age of 18 months old)

For weeks his heart is flooded with pain. Unbelievable pain! Indescribable pain! (I know this personal pain) One late night he finds his journal and attempts to make sense of what is happening to his little boy, to his family, to him, as he puts pen to paper: Nino has cancer. Seeing it written down hurts his stomach. Over the last three weeks of hospital visits and wrenching fears, it has become unreal. Nino has cancer and he is dying! Now it is real!

Nino's favorite book is called "Frosty the Snowman", and tonight on a cold winter time of the year he snuggles into my arms and says daddy read me Frosty. He sits on his daddy's lap and he tries to hold back the tears. His fuzzy hair smells wet and he holds his stuffed teddy bear and he says "sing, Dada, sing." I look down at his clear brown eyes imploring me. I look at his right eye-the eye with the cancer that's killing him.

"Sing, Dada," Nino repeated. He was in his flannel green dinosaur onesie pajamas, and the cold snow was lashing the windows. While the moment of the now counts, Mr. Hanmer will refuse him nothing. He opens the book filled with colored pictures of the snowman, who magically comes to life for the children, and he sings the lines: "Frosty the snowman knew the sun was hot that day, so he said, Let's run, and we'll have some fun now before I melt away." But suddenly he was weeping with waves of salty warm tears, Mr. Hanmer chest heaving with pain of a parent who can do little to save his child. He does not want Nino to melt away..... Please don't let Nino melt away.....

Nino turned the page with his chubby little fingers. "Sing Dada Sing" So his father sang the next line: "He waved goodbye, saying, don't you cry. I'll be back again someday." Mr. Hanmer's stomach convulsed as his little boy asked him to sing the story again. Thumpety thump, thump, thump, thump, over the fields of snow.

After surgeries, and more and more chemo, Nino's soft fuzzy hair was gone. Nino was one of those kids that we see on TV or ads, or one of those kids that you are asked to give money to. They became one of those families that needed counseling, help and a shoulder to cry on. They became a family that needed a community of Spiritual enlightenment to make sense of it all. They became the people who would call me (Hope) in the middle of the night asking for help. They are the type of people who reach out to the HOPE INTERFAITH CENTER! We, Jody and I, see this all the time!

I will never read or sing "Frosty the Snowman" again in the same way to my Greta, little Joe, Matthew, Bella, or Bennie. I shall never stop telling my kids I love them. I am a changed woman because of this temple of light called the Hope Interfaith Center. I know that we have not only touched lives but we have changed lives and have saved lives.

We do not receive grants to support our mission at the Hope Interfaith Center. We do not get support from any large corporations in town!
